RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hard hats marked PAS015, EN1384 must be worn by riders at all times. We strongly advise that body protectors be worn in all jumping classes. Sensible footwear must be worn when mounted or handling horses.

The judges decision is final in all classes, any objections must be accompanied by a £30 deposit and made in writing to the Secretary within 20 minutes of the class ending, deposit will be forfeit if the complaint is not upheld.

Entry fees will not be returned without a vet's or doctor's certificate. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter classes or to refuse entry without stating a reason.

Cantering or galloping on the showground is strictly forbidden except in the designated warm up areas. Whips and spurs are not permitted in the gymkhana events.

£10 returnable deposit is required for each perpetual trophy awarded.

RING 1 - OPEN SHOW JUMPING : 9.30 Start

- Class 1 2'0 – 2'3
- Class 2 2'3 – 2'6
- Class 3 2'6 – 2'9
- Class 4 2'9 Accumulator - fences will have points from
1 to 10 and the competitors have 1 minute to jump
as many fences as possible. A fence knocked down
must not be re-jumped, most points wins
- Class 5 3' – 3'3
- Class 6 3'3 – 3'6

RING 2 - NOVICE SHOW JUMPING : 9.30 Start

not over 2'6

Class 19 Lead Rein Pony 12.2 and under (must wear a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband)

Class 20 Child's 1st Pony off the lead rein, 13.2hh and under, to be judged on suitability for the rider

Class 21 Riding Pony/Horse, may be split into under and over 14.2

Class 22 Best Veteran Horse or Pony 16 years or over, to be judged on condition and movement
